CONTENT

What are the primary actions that you wish for attendees to take when visiting your booth? Ideas include:

[Within 6Connex platform]

- Add items/offers to virtual registration bag
- Watch a video

[Outside of 6Connex platform]

- Link to external content on your website
- Take a survey or play a game
- Open an email inbox
- Schedule a 1:1 meeting

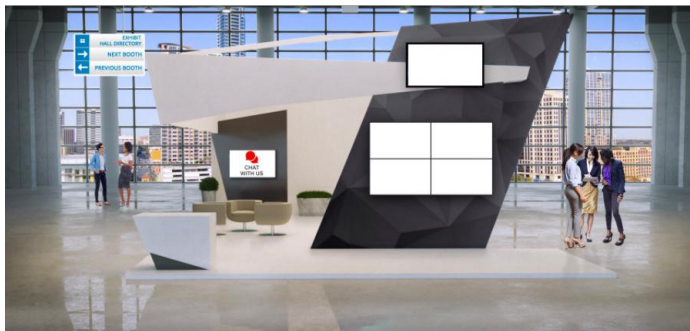

Step 2 : Create your virtual booth and select your template

You will be brought to the Control Panel

Content Library: This is where your images, videos and documents will live if you used enhanced features – NOT needed for basic booth building

Tracking & Metrics: This feature is currently turned off

Using the Control Panel you may control all aspects of your Virtual Site, from who may access it, to what kinds of content, virtual rooms and spaces it will contain, to how you will drive traffic to certain areas through promotions and emailings. After your Virtual Site has launched, you can even track user behavior and the performance of certain areas and content. Please choose an option from the dashboard below to get started!

Welcome,

- Content Library**
In this area, you may create, edit, and manage content items and library.
- Virtual Rooms**
In this area, you may create, edit and manage Virtual Rooms.
- Chat Sessions**
In this area you may create chat sessions which may take place in certain areas or during presentations.
- Tracking & Metrics**
In this area, you may track user behavior and performance of content and areas of the Virtual Site.
- Surveys**
In this area, you may create surveys which may be presented to Users in different areas of the Virtual site.
- Help**

Virtual Rooms: A Booth is considered a “virtual room”. Click this area to start building your booth

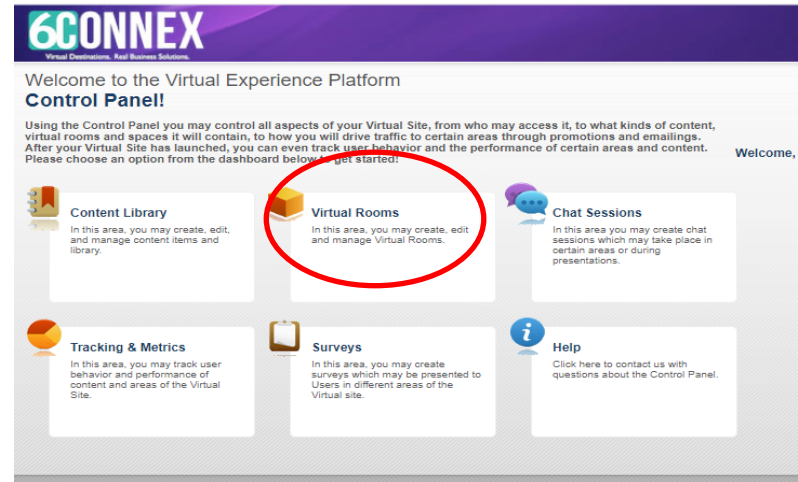
Chat Sessions: This is where you create **moderated** chats. This is not a feature you should use. There is an easier place to create public and 1:1 chats within your booth.

Surveys: This is not currently an active feature within 6Connex

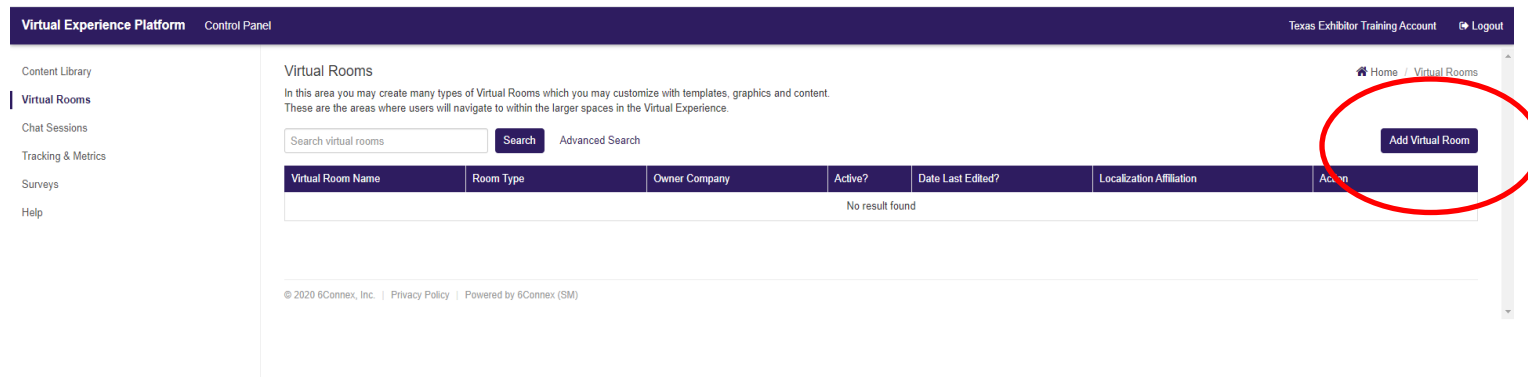


Step 2 (cont'd): Create your virtual booth and select your template

First, click “Virtual Rooms”



Then click “Add Virtual Room”





Step 2 (cont'd): Create your virtual booth and select your template

This will open a new tab in your browser, and you will be asked to answer the booth set up questions:


Welcome to Virtual Builder


Here you can easily setup each room or space in your virtual experience.


Virtual Builder allows you to:


- Choose new templates or edit existing templates
- Change background design
- Add images and graphics
- Assign click actions
- Assign content from content library


Once your room is setup, you can come back at any time to assign content or make adjustments.

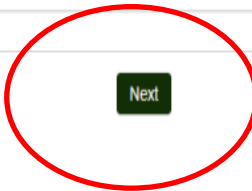

Type – select “Booth”

Name – Your company name as you want attendees to see it

Description – 240 characters or less; can be description of your company that attendees will see OR an invitation for attendees to come into your booth

Location Key – enter your company name as you entered it above, *but without any spaces*

Language Affiliation – click English

Time Bracket – leave blank

Active – select “Yes”

Click “Next” to continue



Step 2 (cont'd): Create your virtual booth and select your template

Select your template, then press "Create Booth"

Select Your Template

In this step, you can choose from existing templates, or you can create your own template by starting with a background design.

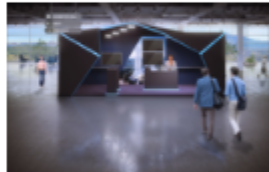
Each Virtual Room includes:

- A background design
- Images on top of the background design
- Specified click states and associated actions

Images and click states are Elements that can be managed on the next step.

Note: Within Virtual Builder, all existing templates can be modified for use in your specific virtual environment.

Step 2 (cont'd): Create your virtual booth and select your template

Your booth template will now open in a separate tab.

Manage Room Elements

In this step you can manage all the elements in your Room template.

Assign graphics, content, logos, links
Select a new template or manage the existing template.

Select "Filter Elements", then check the box for the specific element you want to manage.

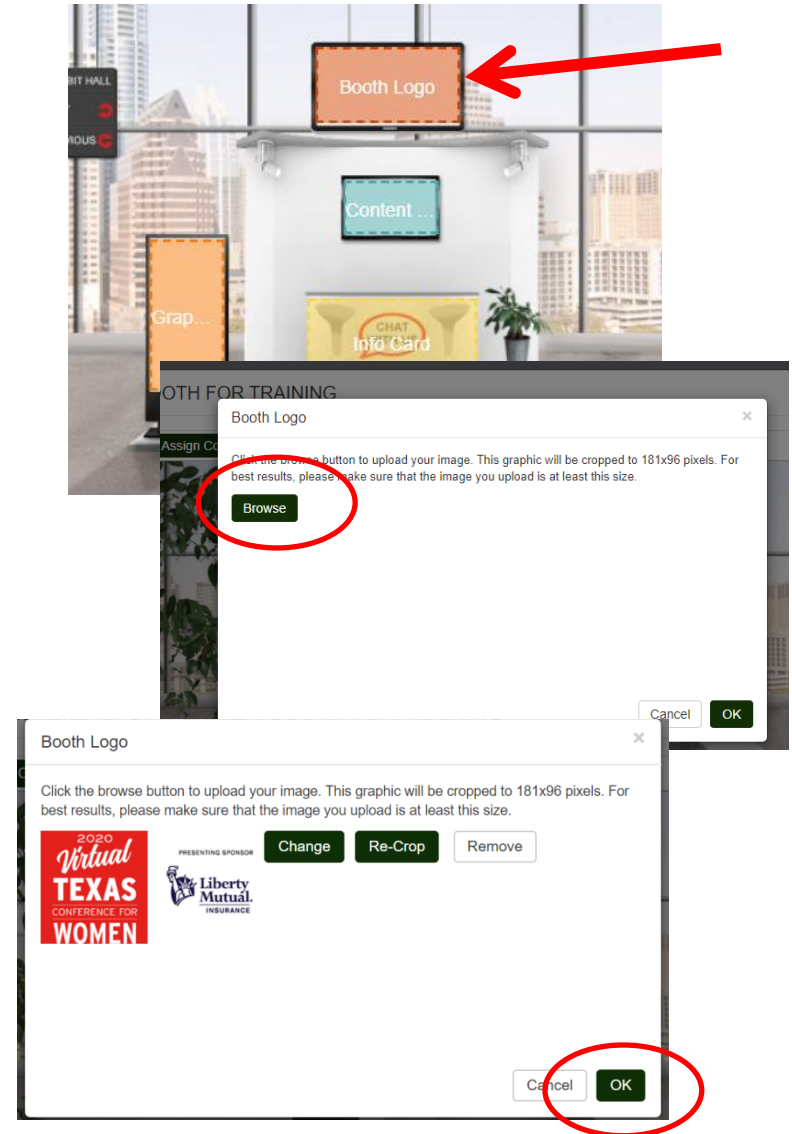

Step 3: Add your booth logo

- Click on the area that says “Booth Logo”
- A pop up will appear. Click “Browse” and select the logo from your computer that you want to use. Please note:
 - Your logo must be a rectangle (i.e., if your logo is a different shape, you will need to choose a version of your logo that has a rectangular background – either transparent or color)
 - The size of your booth logo will be 180x100 pixels, but a cropping tool is available in the system if you are unable to re-size prior to uploading
- Once you upload your image, you will have the opportunity to crop it using the dashed grid. Click “Crop” on the bottom right once set.
- View the cropped logo. If you need to make changes, click “Change” or “Re-Crop”. *This logo will be used in a number of places, so it is important that you get it just right in this phase!* When you like it, click “OK”.

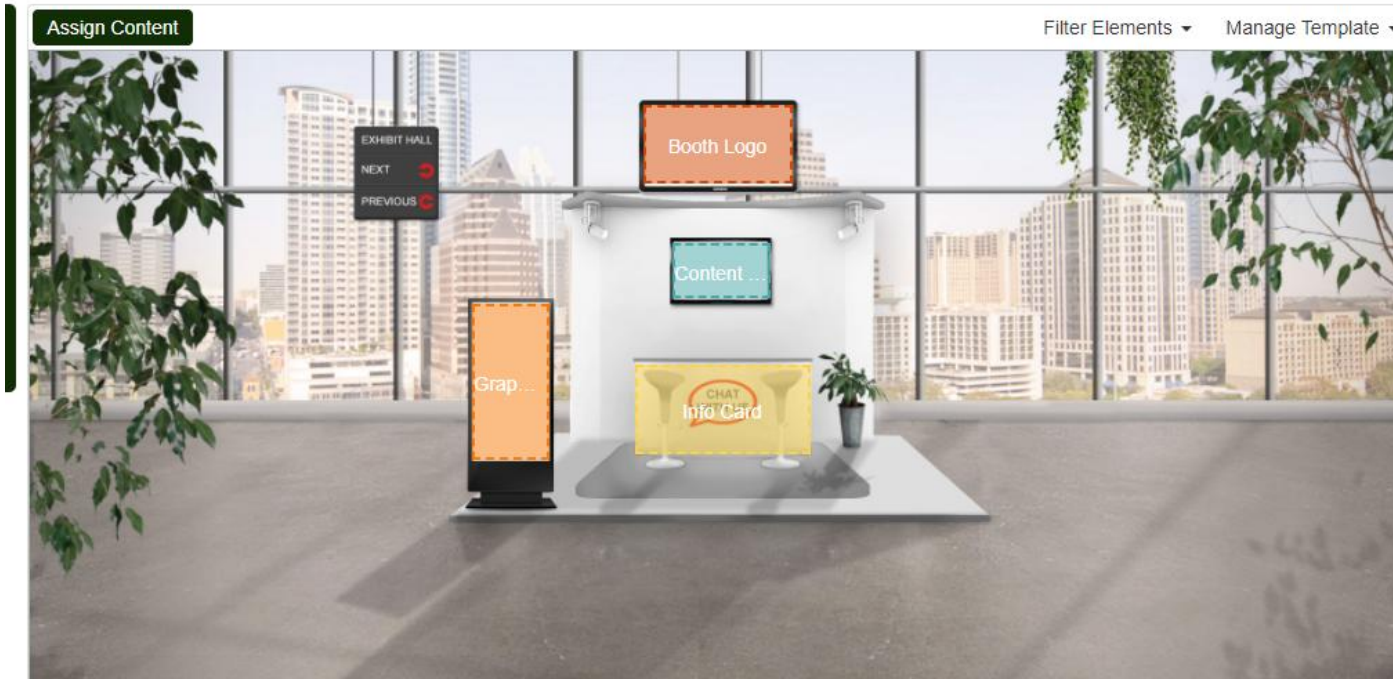




Be sure to click “Save” in the upper right corner **EVERY TIME** you make a change

Tip: When you see an asterisk next to the word “Save” on the green button, that indicates that you have unsaved work and need to Save!



Step 4: Making edits

The next time you log into the 6Connex system, you will see your booth listed under “Virtual Rooms”. Click “Edit” on the right-hand side to return to your booth template view.

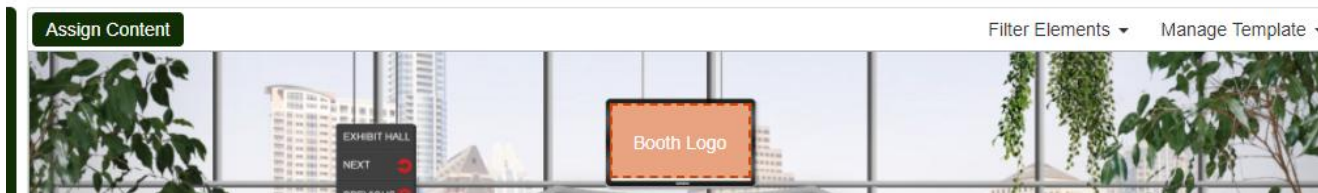
